She is responsible for overseeing the operation and management of all finance activities, grants, information technology and human resources. She also directs the data, research and evaluation affairs of CSB and is responsible for program and system evaluations necessary for programmatic and planning decisions. She oversees the work of the Rebuilding Lives Funder Collaborative – the local continuum of care for Columbus and Franklin County’s programs funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. She holds a master’s degree in business administration from the Ohio State University Fisher College of Business and an undergraduate degree in computer sciences.

Community Shelter Board is a collective impact organization working to prevent and end homelessness by creating collaborations, developing innovative solutions, and investing in quality programs in Columbus and Franklin County. Community Shelter Board oversees an annual budget of \$31 million to support homeless programs and services. Last year, these programs served more than 12,000 people.
