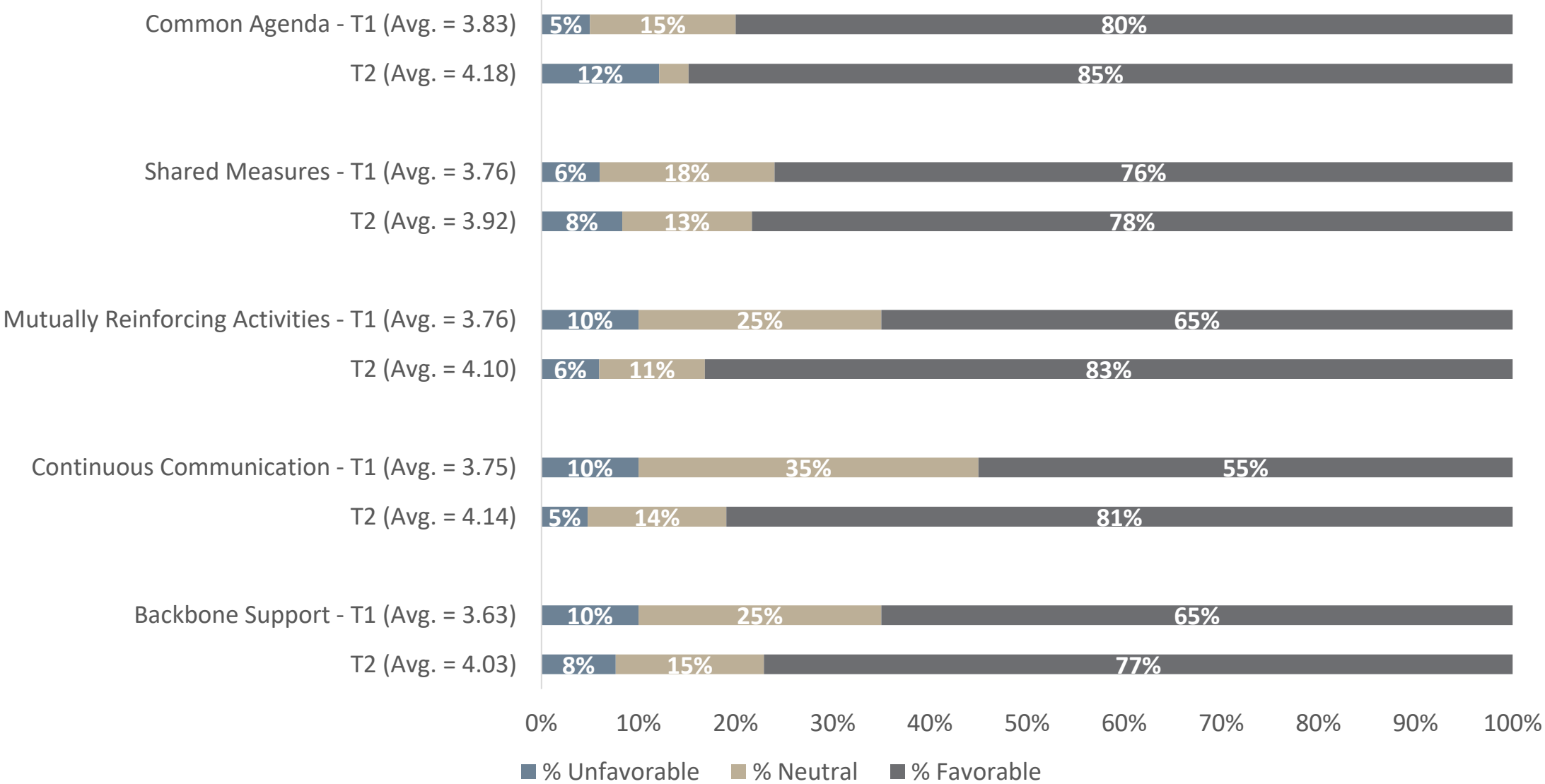


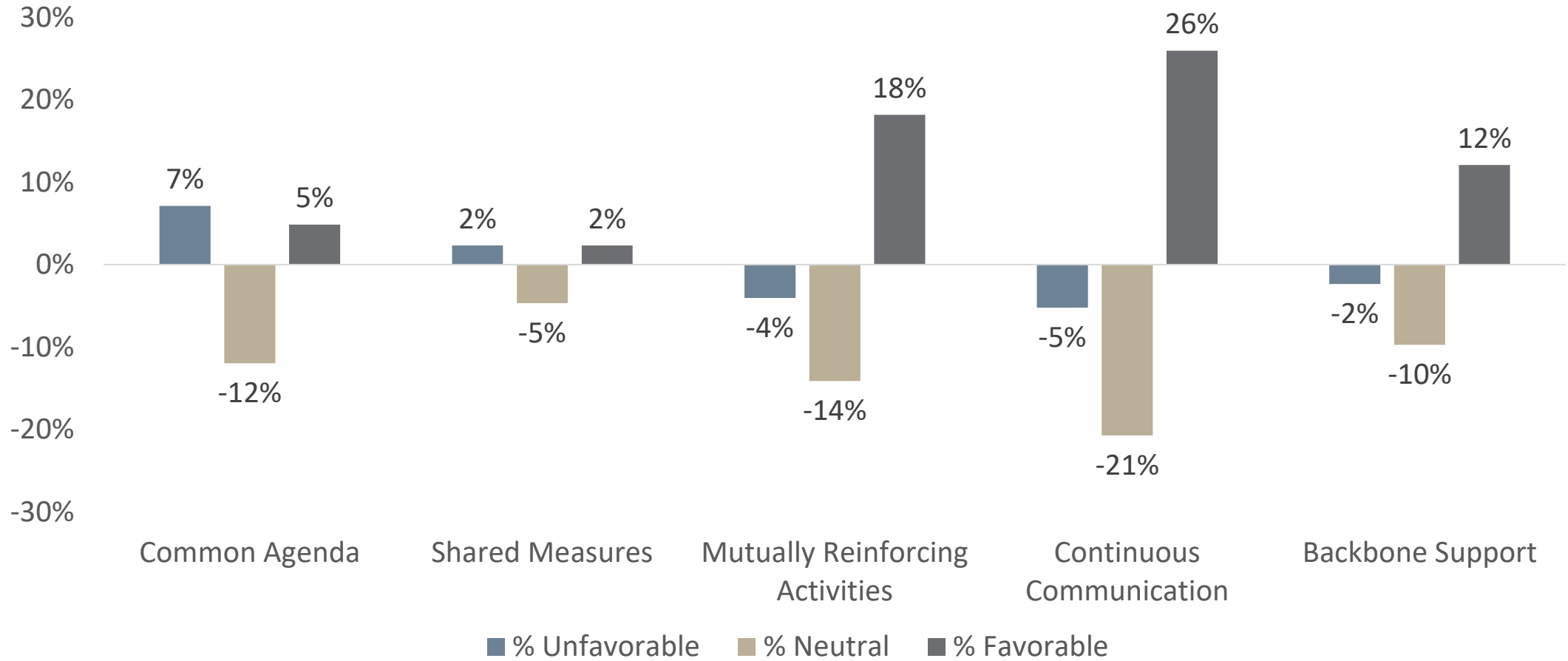
Effective Collective Impact Behavior

Goal: Achieve and maintain high levels of effective collective impact behaviors as indicated by a scale score of 4 or higher on a 5-point scale.

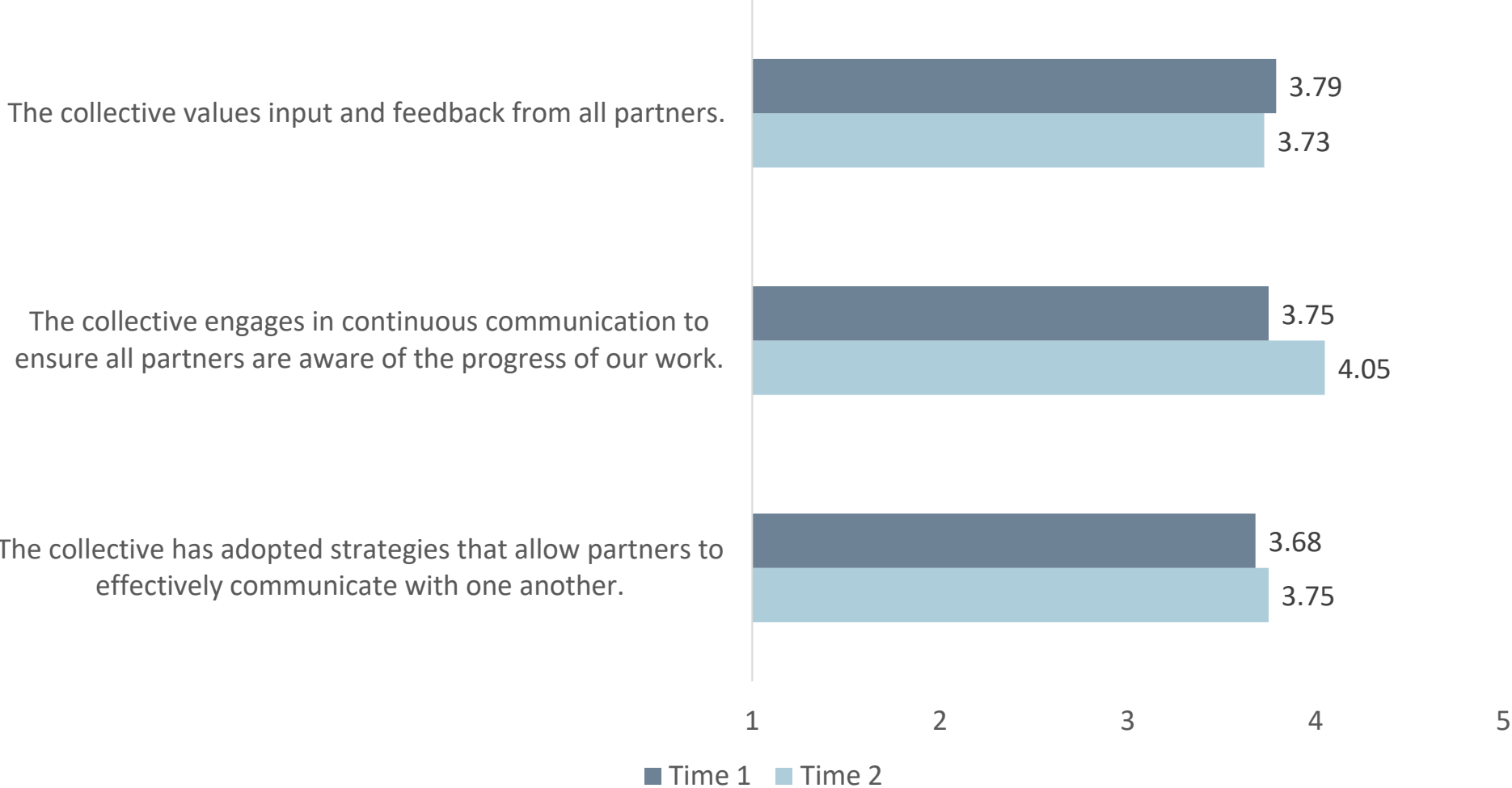
Favorability of Partnerships from Time 1 (T1) to Time 2 (T2)



Percent Change in Favorability from Time 1 to Time 2



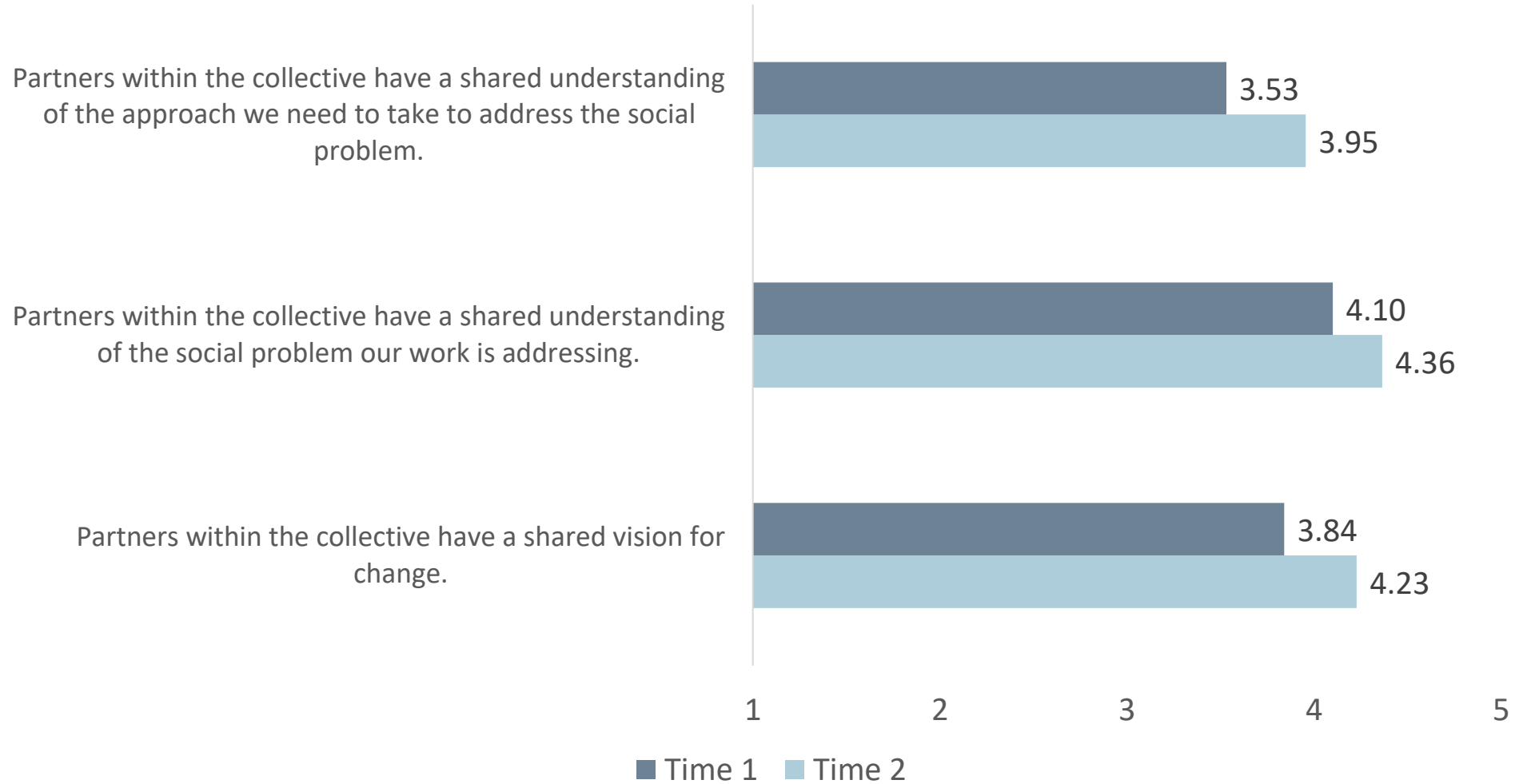

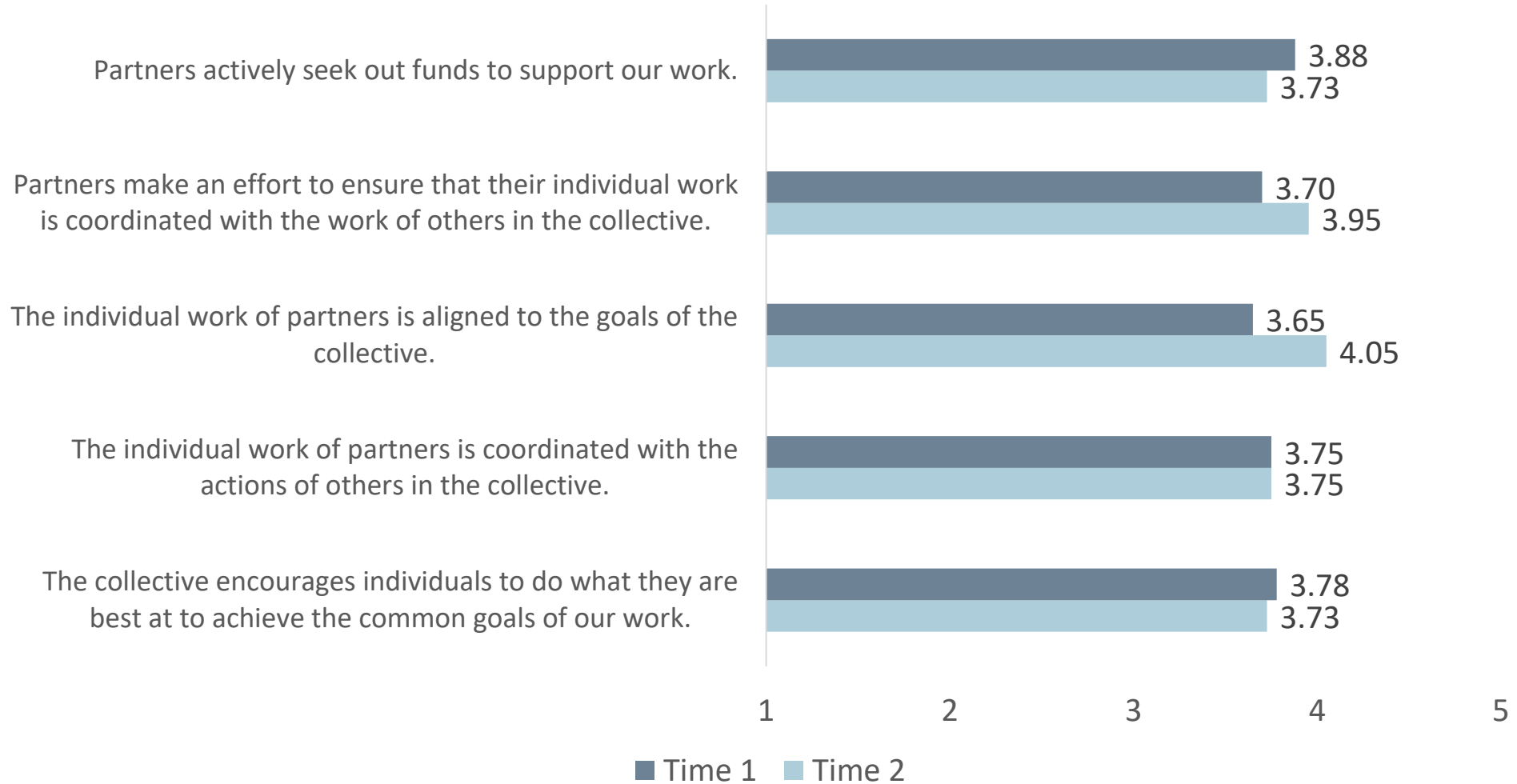

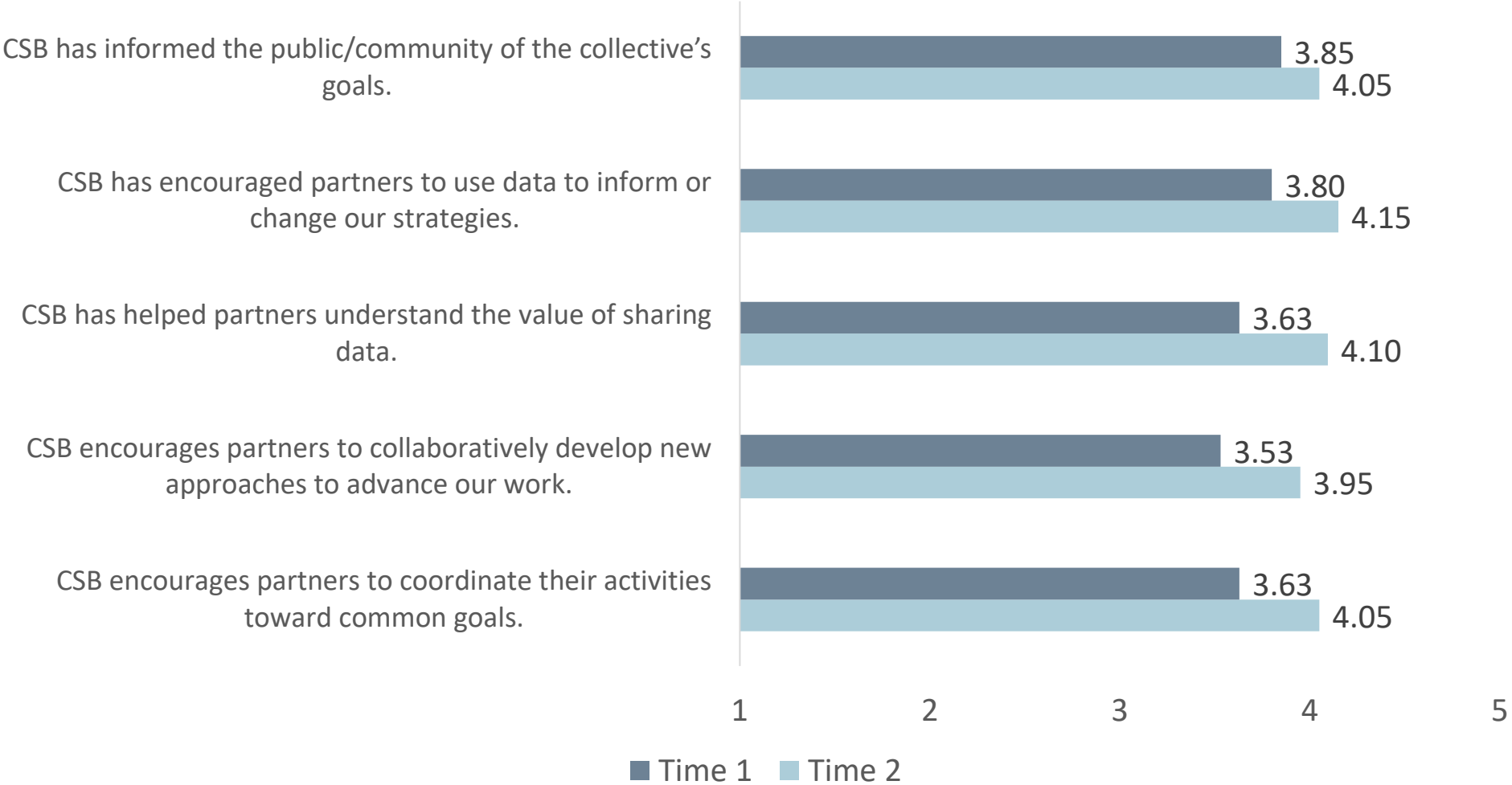

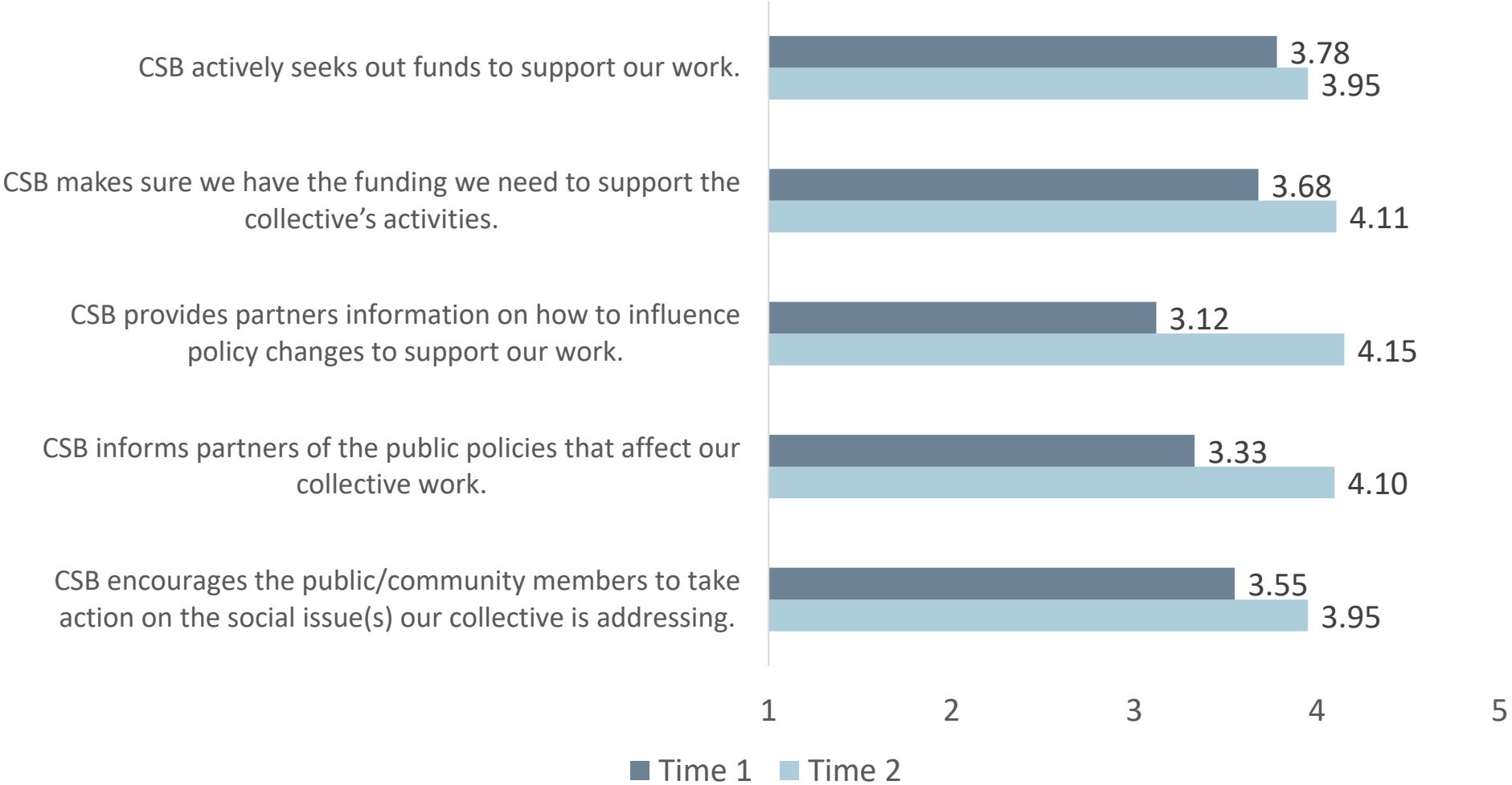
