Social Security Administration is offering a 2-part series training

What is the SSI Vulnerable Population Application Project? This national initiative allows trusted community partners to submit full SSI/SSDI claims directly to local Social Security Administration (SSA) offices after completing both training modules. The SSI VPAP Application Project was created to assist in addressing a national decline in SSI claims over the last years during the pandemic, and to assist people facing barriers in the SSI/SSDI application process.

Who is doing the training? Session trainers are Social Security employees from around Central and Southern Ohio. Both sessions are conducted via Teams links.

How does the SSI Vulnerable Population Project help our organization? By training your organization to complete paper SSI applications and online SSDI applications, your clients do not have to wait for a phone appointment with a local office. This can save weeks to months off the disability application.

Does my organization have to officially represent a client in this project, or submit medical forms? No, you are assisting the clients in completing the forms, but you do not have to be an authorized representative nor provide any additional documentation to participate in the project!
